Wyoming State DKG Personal Growth Grant

One Personal Growth Grant of \$200 is available each year to one active Wyoming DKG member who is no longer teaching. Selection is based on the applicant's commitment to personal growth



such as self-improvement, creativity, new interests, critical thinking skills, leadership, or improvement of intercultural relations. The grant must be used during the calendar year issued, and the experience should provide evidence of growth that must be shared. DEVELOPMENT AWARD

Cornetet Individual Awards for Professional Development (CIPD) are available to all employed educators who meet the stated criteria. The application process is competitive.

Awards (money) given to individual educators assist their participation in professional development opportunities through approved providers such as colleges, universities, and professional organizations, other than The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International. Over \$699,547 has been granted as Individual Professional Development Awards as of 2018.

Awards will fund participation in:

- Conferences
- Seminars
- Lecture series
- National certification (maximum award for the National Board Certification will be \$1,000.00)
- Online courses
- Workshops and other non-degree programs

Awards may fund travel, lodging, meals, pay for substitutes, registration fees, etc. Awards may not be used to reimburse for activities already completed, to pursue a degree program, or to fund an educational project. Applications are available on the International Website. Next deadline is Feb. 1st.
