growth such as self-improvement, creativity, new interests, critical thinking skills, leadership, or improvement of intercultural relations. The grant must be used during the calendar year issued, and the experience should provide evidence of growth that must be shared. #### Upsilon Chapter Member Graduate/Post Graduate Scholarship

Upsilon Chapter will offer Scholarships for Graduate/Post Graduate degree work. Minimum requirements are: Active member of DKG Upsilon for at least 2 years who has been accepted for graduate work in an approved



institution of higher learning, or student in good standing in an approved program. Applicant must be employed in education or planning to return to education upon completion of degree. The scholarship may also be used for National Board Certification. The number and amount of the scholarships awarded will vary depending upon available funds. Active working members may apply more than one time, but may only be awarded the scholarship twice.
