Due to visibility being a challenge this year with workers being in different rooms, I offer this information to help members understand more about NON-MEMBER the what



HELPERS (Boy Scouts, Adult Scouters, and Base personnel) can do to help them during our Used Book Sale.

The NON-MEMBER HELPERS at the book sale



have been directed to assist the DKG members as needed. Remembering that many of these non-

member helpers have not assisted with the book sale before, you need to explain the "how" of the job needing done. Please request their assistance for specific jobs you need assistance, including:

1. Carrying filled and bulky or heavy flats or boxes to the book drop

Be sure the buyers print their names on the sticky tab and explain to the buyer that the tab must be given to the helpers at the book drop area.




2. Offering the buyer another flat to continue looking.

Explain to the **NON-MEMBER HELPERS**:

- 1) Where extra flats are located,
- 2) How to offer them to the buyers, and
- 3) Where to get extra boxes from the

storage area.

3. Moving books from the floor to table



- The older/bigger boys can move boxes up onto the table for you. DO NOT HURT YOURSELF by lifting boxes that are too heavy.
- **4.** Running errands as requested by buyers, Adult Scouters and DKG members
